Word Order: SVO

Possessee - Possessor

Pronouns:

	Past	Future
I	nno	ka
You (SG)	o	e
He	mV*	a

\*V is the first vowel in the verb root

Common nouns as subjects have 3sg pronoun (i.e. mV or a) (N is the possessed noun, i.e. possessee)

Possessions:	SUFFIX
my	-ku
your (SG)	-m
his	-na
of a common noun	-n COMMON NOUN

Types: Inalienable (relatives, body parts): N-SUFFIX

People/property/object: N no-SUFFIX

Animal (except pig): N bula-SUFFIX

Food: N a-SUFFIX

Drink: N ma-SUFFIX
